At the September meeting, PEATC will present, "Is Your Child a Target of Bullying?" This workshop, which offers intervention strategies for parents of children with disabilities who may be the target of bullying at school, will help participants learn how to: identify types of bullying, develop strategies to prevent bullying, identify responses to bullying, talk to their child about bullying, obtain help from professionals, and find out about disability harassment laws.
